Board of Education Meeting Thursday, May 1, 2014

The following Lynch Elementary students led the Board and audience in the pledge of allegiance; Alayna Brown, Kennedi Dreffs, Christian Huyghe, Jordan Richards, Brooklynn Sinclair, and Matthew Smiley.

Lynch Elementary School Principal Michelle Bradford presented information on Lynch Elementary School. Learning Coach Kasie Allen and teachers Amber Weidinger, Kelly Orlando, Jennifer Rondy and Anne Burkhardt presented information on a program they have been piloting this year that has them teaching in "rounds". Teaching in "rounds" helps teachers develop common teaching practices.

Students Alayna Brown, Kennedi Dreffs, Christian Huyghe, Jordan Richards, Brooklyn Sinclair, and Matthew Smiley presented information on projects they have been working on in class.

Jonathan Nugent reported on the F&O Meeting that was held on April 24 when the following items were discussed: Middle School Locker Bid; LHS Music Storage Room Cabinet Bid; Lapeer High School Cafeteria Equipment Bid; LHS Gym Bleachers; Lawn Mowing Bids; Elba Property Use Restrictions Request; and ISD 2014-2015 Proposed Budget.

The following items were approved by the Board:

- A special meeting will be held at 5 PM on May 8, 2014
- The high school cafeteria equipment bid was awarded to Culinary Products, Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$126,686
- The music storage room cabinet bid was awarded to Architectural Systems Group for an amount not to exceed \$27,990.
- The Lapeer High School gymnasium bleacher bid was awarded to Interkal, LLC, for an amount not to exceed \$148,022.
- The middle school locker bid was awarded to Steel Equipment Company for an amount not to exceed \$37,500.
- B&B Lawn and Landscape was awarded the lawn maintenance bid for Cramton, Schickler, Rolland-Warner, Zemmer, Lapeer High School, and the West Campus for an amount not to exceed \$1,085 per mow and Carey's Lawn & Snow Care was awarded the lawn maintenance bid for ASC, Lynch, Maple Grove, Mayfield, Murphy, Turrill, and Bus Garage for an amount not to exceed \$650 per mow.
- Jonathan Nugent will represent the Board of Education at the Annual ISD Meeting scheduled for 7 PM on May 21, 2014. Wendy Byard will serve as the alternate if Mr. Nugent is unable to attend.
- The 2014-2015 ISD Budget was approved as presented.

Board members thanked Mrs. Bradford, staff and students for their presentations. Mr. Oyster reminded Board members and those present that we have five candidates running for the opening for State Representative for Lapeer County. He encouraged everyone to scrutinize the candidates so they can be informed prior to voting in the August primary.

Superintendent Matt Wandrie shared that he was honored to be asked by the House Fiscal Agency to help address a solution for funding to districts with declining student enrollment. He is excited to be a part of this and will be submitting a recommendation to the Speaker of the House on Friday.

Mr. Wandrie thanked Mr. Zeeman for organizing a meeting with more than 600 current East and West athletes in order to introduce them to the new fall and winter coaches. It was wonderful to see all the students come together as one group.
