## **Board of Education Meeting Thursday, December 4, 2014**

The Zemmer Choir, under the direction of Mr. Tom Kaiser, led the Board and audience in the pledge of allegiance and then performed *Silent Night*.

Zemmer Co-Principals, Jennifer Taylor and Aaron Shinn, along with Associate Principal Barb Bennett, reviewed how Zemmer is working to meet the District Goals. Teachers Carlene Lagrasso and Beth Willette reviewed the numerous instructional and behavioral practices that have been put in place this year in order to give students extra support.

Michelle Bradford and Matt Olson updated the Board on the new spring testing protocols. They shared changes that are required and how they will be using the new testing center set up at the Center for Innovation.
