**Finance and Operation Committee** – Peggy Bush reported on the Finance and Operation Committee Meeting that was held on April 14 when lawn mowing bids and food service bid was discussed.

**DISCUSSION ITEMS**

**ISD Biennial Election Resolution** – It was the consensus of the Board that Jon Nugent represent the Board of Education at the ISD Biennial Election Meeting on June 1 at 7 PM. Peggy Bush will serve as the alternate if Jon is unable to attend. Official action appointing Mr. Nugent and Mrs. Bush will be taken at the special meeting scheduled for May 21.

**M-STEP Update** – Michelle Bradford updated the Board on the M-STEP testing that began this week. M-STEP (Michigan Student Test of Educational Progress) is the replacement for the MEAP and the MME. Students in grades 3 through 8, as well at 11<sup>th</sup> graders, are being tested. She explained the District has set up almost 800 computer testing stations at Zemmer, Lapeer High School, and the Center for Innovation, so multiple students can test at the same time. She was happy to report they had minimal technology problems thanks to the wonderful tech support from Nick Ward and Michelle Pheiffer.
